UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

ACA's uniform policy is in place to provide a standard dress code for all students, which promotes school-appropriate dress and limits unnecessary distraction.

DAILY UNIFORM:

Navy blue or white three to four-button polo shirts (short or long-sleeved)
Navy blue or white turtlenecks
Navy blue or tan khaki pants* or shorts (shorts must be mid-thigh or longer)
Navy blue or white sweaters or ACA sweatshirts or jackets over their uniforms
Sneakers or shoes (no sandals, slides, or flip-flops)

In addition, girls may wear navy blue or tan khaki skirts, skorts or jumpers (as long as they reach mid-thigh or longer) and navy blue leggings (under jumpers, skirts or skorts)* for additional warmth in the winter.

**Yoga pants, compression pants and leggings
are not considered pants and may not be worn in place of them.**

PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM:

PE uniforms must be purchased through ACA. They consist of ACA-logo tee shirts, shorts, sweatpants, sweatshirts and hoodies. Go to www.acaschool.net click "store" icon or go to www.globalschoolwear.com

Sneakers must be worn on PE days.

DRESS DOWN DAYS:

Dress Down Days are the last Friday of every month. Students are welcome to wear casual clothing. On these days, students must abide by the spirit of the code, which is school-appropriate attire.

School-appropriate attire for Dress Down Days:

- Yoga pants, compression pants, and leggings are not considered pants and may not be worn in place of them.
- Pants or shorts with writing across the seat are not allowed.
- Any rips or holes in pants must not expose skin above the mid-thigh.
- Any clothing with graphics or words must be Christian-school appropriate.
- Clothing must cover students' undergarments and bellies.
- Skirts and shorts must be mid-thigh or longer in length.
- No tank tops, spaghetti straps or camisoles are permitted.
- Footwear must fit securely on the students' feet; no flip-flops are permitted. Shoes may not have a heel higher than 1 inch.
